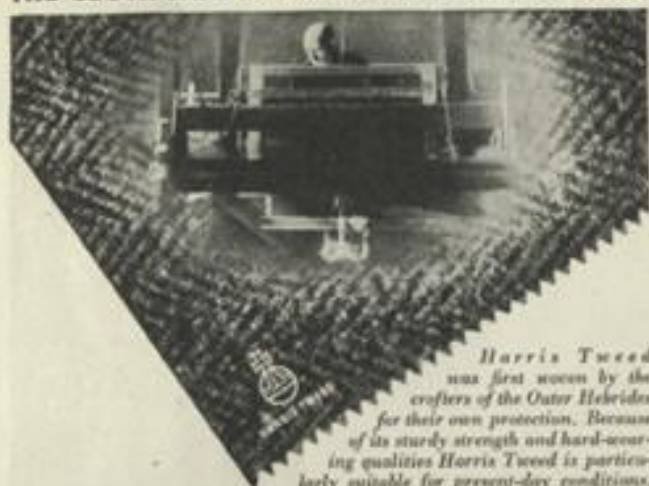


THE CLOTH THAT BEARS THE MARK OF IDENTITY

As a safeguard against imitations the Harris Tweed Trade Mark has been registered by order of the Board of Trade. All Tweed which bears the Harris Tweed Trade Mark is made today in the same way as before the War. The mark, stamped on the cloth itself, is a guarantee that the tweed has been made entirely in the Outer Hebrides, from pure Scottish wool, and has been hand-woven at the homes of the islanders.
